This position requires someone with a strong musical background who is comfortable working with youth and flexible enough to collaborate with multiple



ensembles, productions, and soloists as needed. Accompanists will play an integral role in rehearsals and performances, contributing to the overall success of our programs.

Responsibilities

The successful candidate will:

- Provide accompaniment for the Junior or Senior choir during morning sessions and, if required, the Music Makers Choir or the Musical Theatre productions in the afternoon, depending on program needs.
- Work independently and collaboratively with staff to deliver high-quality music education.
- Assist in planning and executing performances and activities alongside other staff members.
- Foster an inclusive environment where all students feel welcomed, supported, and valued.
- Prioritize the safety and well-being of all KISSM participants.
- Support Choir, Band, and Musical Theatre Faculty as needed.
- Attend staff meetings and maintain clear communication by reviewing updates from the Music Director and Administrative Team.
