The primary responsibility will be ensuring that the needs of our youngest participants are met, fostering a safe and supportive environment throughout their camp experience.

Nature of work

The Music Makers Faculty Member will lead children in activities designed to stimulate and develop their intellectual, physical, and emotional growth, while ensuring their safety and well-being throughout the camp day.
